It could mean the nine steps Thor takes, after delivering the ending blow to Jormungandr. It could mean the eight additional rings that Draupnir drops, every ninth night. It can mean the nine proper faiths, that are originally pulled from our sources in Asatru.

Connected to the Nine Noble Virtues, we the NFK use Nine Faiths to help combat racism, bigotry and white supremacy, taking back our values that were wrongfully displayed from the start.

The NFK believes if we don't fight back by properly using our faith, our symbols, our values, our sources, then we surrender all that including the faith itself to the evil that misuses it.
