

NFK'S MISSION STATEMENT



The NFK's Mission Statement starting with symbolization, The Valknut is a symbol that was used by our ancestors, in old Norse times. This symbol was found on a couple of archaeological records and carvings of old Germanic Peoples. The symbol does not have a clear definition that we know of, but in modern times especially in Norwegian cultures it means "knot of the fallen in battle. It is also known in modern culture as "knot of the slain" and it was given this definition due to the finds where this symbol was found.

The Valknut was often found at burial sites, and ancient stone carvings. Common links with this symbol would be the fallen warriors, the dead, and possible reincarnations. Odin himself is heavily close with the use of this symbol, some archaeologists even think that this symbol is the symbol of the Valkyries raising the slain, to take them to Valhalla.

Unfortunately, like lots of this faith, this symbol like many others have fallen in the hands of hate groups, white supremacist, and other racial communities. The fight for our symbols and faith starts with us, and us alone, and therefore Nine Faith Kindred chose to use the Valknut as the main symbol of its representation. If we stop using the symbols that have records of our faith and our ancestors' beliefs, then we forfeit this whole faith alone. Our fight to combat racism, and negative use of our symbols must start with using them correctly. Nine Faith Kindred uses the Valknut in relation to the All-Father himself, Odin. Rather if you want to believe Valhalla is waiting for, or if you

believe in reincarnation, the symbol of the Valknut should represent the upbringing of the dead and giving the chance to live again.



There are other theories of the Valknut such as all points of the triangles mean the nine realms of the world tree, Yggdrasil. Small theories also believe the nine points of the triangles also mean the nine faiths in the Nine Noble Virtues, and this alone is also a strong meaning behind the Nine Faith Kindred and why we use this symbol. NFK will continue to fight for our symbols, that naturally were found in our history. Allowing them to fall in the hands of negative groups and clans, is what we, the NFK stand against.

- **Negative actions, regarding members of NFK, in any way shape or form.**
- **Acceptance of members with sexual assault backgrounds.**
- **Acceptance of members with ties or connection to current racist, or hateful groups or kindreds.**

- **The negative use of its symbols, or representation in any way.**
- **Physical, Verbal, or Mental abuse to its members, or affiliates in any way.**

The NFK's goal is to build a Norse Pagan, Pagan of all community, which backs the Nine Noble Virtues, and displays positive faith among all, including families, society, and its own kindred. NFK hopes to bring pagans together in a nonjudgmental environment, where people can learn, discuss, celebrate, and grow in this beautiful faith.
